

DENİZLİ CARD for STUDENT:

One pass -1.75 TL

80 Multi-pass- 90 TL (30 days)

To apply for a bus pass, you can go to Denizli Büyükşehir Belediyesi Ulaşım AŞ. Kart Dolum - Kart Basım Merkezi (Denizli Municipality Card Print Center) in Denizli Özel İdare İshani in the city center on Gazi Mustafa Kemal Bulvarı Street. You need to pay 5 TL to issue your card for the first time and it will include one pass. Once you get your bus pass, you can load money on the card through loading points in and around the campus.



Required Documents for Application: Student Document (or Student identity card) and one passport photo

Banderol: Within the first week of each academic semester, you can take your banderol from your academic advisor.

(It will be stuck at the back of your student identity card.)

**OGS for PRIVATE CARS**

You need to get a sticker for your private car to use automatic pass system (OGS). The fee for OGS sticker is 75 TL, which you should pay in 3-month instalments.

ON CAMPUS TRANSPORTATION



**WHAT IS PUSULA INFO SYSTEM?**

With PAU PUSULA Information System, you can view your grades, register lessons, and access many academic information. After registering at Pamukkale University, your username and password must be sent to you by SMS. You can log in with your username and password at <https://pusula.pau.edu.tr/>. You can also examine student communities from the SKS submenu and choose which one you want to become a member of. Do not forget to follow the communities from social media and go to meetings after you become a member
:) All student communities are excited to meet you :)



HOW TO GET AN E-MAIL ACCOUNT?

The e-mail account is created automatically by the Computer Center. When the accounts are created, the first letter of your name, the whole surname and the last two digits of the entrance year are combined as your user name and your username and password must be sent to you via SMS during registration. Using this information, you can log in to your email account at xxxxxx18@posta.pau.edu.tr.

You can login at <http://eposta.pau.edu.tr> to access your e-mail account. If you forget your password and / or username, you can click on the link "I do not know my password or user name" at the bottom of the PAU Pusula Information System login screen (pusula.pau.edu.tr). The new password will come as SMS to the registered mobile phone in the system.

WHAT IS ESS (EDUCATION SUPPORT SYSTEM)?

It was established in order to ensure that the courses offered at our university are administered via internet. You can access the lessons of the active periods by using Pusula system user name and password and you can follow your lessons through this system. Functioning is simple as follows: At the beginning of the teaching period, the lecturer uploads the course material into ESS; so you can track the material the teacher has shared online, see the assigned assignments, and upload your own assignments to the system. ESS is also an educational platform that is enriched with quizzes that measure your level of understanding the course materials and have forums where you can exchange views and talk to your classmates about your topic. HOW TO EAT WITH STUDENT CARD?

You can load money in your student card at the dining hall, at the PAU Café and at the Ay (Moon) Café. Later, when you go to the queue for the meal to pass through the turnstile, the meal fee is automatically deducted from your card. The red and green saloon meal costs 2.5 TL with a PAU student card. On the same day, the second meal is 7.5 TL. You can also eat at the Moon Café and the PAU Café using your student card.

WHERE CAN I EAT?

Pamukkale University Kınıklı Campus Cafeteria has two saloons for serving the students; the green and white saloons. There are also Denizli Technical Sciences Vocational High School and Gümüşler Campus cafeterias. Our students come up with 4 types of meals that are adequate and balanced to meet daily energy, protein, vitamin and mineral requirements. Lunch is served at the white saloon and lunch and dinner are served at the green saloon. Lunches start to be given on the 2nd week after the beginning of the lessons. Evening meals are provided as long as the lessons of the evening students continue. In orange and red saloons, only academic and administrative staff are provided with catering services.

In addition to the cafeteria lounges, there are White Café, Havuzbaşı (Poolside) Café & Restaurant, Paü Café, Ay Café, Vitamin Café, Göl (Lake) Café, Yakut Café and Zümrüt (Emerald) Café. Apart from these, there are also canteens in each faculty.

WHITE SALOON

Central Dining Hall The White Saloon located on the 1st floor is designed for lunch and has a capacity of 900 people. Lunch is served between 11.30-13.30.





GREEN SALOON

The Green Hall located in the main dining hall 2nd floor is for lunch and dinner and can serve 700 people.

Lunch is between 11.30-13.30; dinners are served between 16.00-17.30.

WHITE CAFE

In the White Café located on the 1st floor of the main dining hall, fast food service (meatball, döner, pizza, etc.) is provided between 11.30-14.00 hours. A vegetarian pizza option is also available.



MORPHOLOGY CAFETERIA

There is lunch between 11.30-13.30 at the cafeteria located under the Congress Cultural Center.

POOLSIDE CAFE & RESTAURANT

The cafe's rich menu includes hot and cold local and foreign coffee varieties as well as breakfast, various main dishes and snack foods in the kitchen. The two-storey café has a total capacity of 400 people with indoor and outdoor areas and serves between 08.00 - 23.00 every day of the week.





PAU CAFE

It is open between 08.00 and 20.00 hours on the ground floor of the Central Dining Hall. All kinds of coffee, hot / cold drinks and pastries are available.

AY CAFE

Soup service between 07.45 - 09.45 hours, fast food service between 11.00 - 20.00 hours (meatball, döner, pizza etc.) is given at Ay Cafe. A vegetarian pizza option is also available.



SOCIAL FACILITIES (GUESTHOUSE RESTAURANT)

Located on the ground floor of the Pamukkale University Guest House, the restaurant offers breakfast, snacks, pastas, pides, pizzas, main meals (grilled meat, chicken shish, meatballs on tile etc) and a variety of hot and cold drinks. A vegetarian pizza option is also available. The restaurant is open between 08.00-00.00.





VITAMIN CAFE

Pamukkale University Vitamin Café located on the entrance floor of Şehit Ömer Halisdemir Sports Center offers freshly squeezed fruit juices, cold and hot drinks and healthy sandwiches. natural products are served. You can check the working hours of Şehit Ömer Halisdemir Sports Center.



LAKE CAFE

You can study at the Lake Café, which is located next to the campus lake, facing the lake view, or spend your leisure time in nature.



YAKUT CAFE

The café located at the entrance of the PAU Hospitals Bed Service serves with an indoor capacity of 240 people and an outdoor capacity of 60 people and toast, hamburger, juicy food, bakery products and pastry varieties can be found at the cafe. There is also a grocery store. Yakut Café is open 24 hours. Payments are made with the card system.

EMERALD CAFE

In the cafe serving between 06.00-23.00, bakery products, biscuit and cakes, rice pudding, profiterole etc. as well as a variety of soups and stews are available. Payments are made with the card system.

IN CASE OF LOSING THE STUDENT CARD

In case of losing student ID card, you have to apply with the Student Affairs Department in Rectorate Building together with the ID Card. Once the missing identity form is filled in, it should be approved by the Security Directorate. This form is required to be delivered to the Office of Student Affairs with the receipt of the 10 TL fee paid to the Halk Bank branch.

HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS STUDENT DISCIPLINARY REGULATION

IMPORTANT ITEMS

It is a disciplinary offense that requires a penalty of reprimand,

Attempting to copy during the exams,

Tearing, altering, scolding or polluting the announcements, programs and the like hanged in the university.

It is a disciplinary offense in the university that requires a penalty of temporary debarment from the university for a week or a month,

Drinking alcoholic beverages in the university,

Organizing meetings in closed and open spaces belonging to the university without permission from the authorities,

Engaging in verbal or written actions that impair the honor and dignity of the people of the university,

Having oral or written actions that damage the honor and dignity of the university staff, inside or outside the institution.

It is a disciplinary offense that requires a debarment penalty for one semester from the university,

Threatening university personnel and students,

Actual attacks on university personnel and students,

Cheating or allowing cheating in exams,

Making plagiarism in seminars, theses and publications

It is a disciplinary offense that requires a debarment penalty of two semesters from the university,

Using, carrying and keeping drugs and other stimulants in the university

Cheating with threat in the exams, preventing the students who cheat from being removed from the exam room, getting the exam instead of someone else or making someone get the exam instead of oneself

Sexual harassment

It is a disciplinary offense that requires a penalty of sending down,

Selling, purchasing, giving to others and trading in drugs or stimulants in higher education institutions,

Establishing an organization for the purpose of committing a crime, to administer such an organization or to become an organized member for this purpose, to act or assist on behalf of the organization,

Violating the sexual immunity of persons by having sexual behavior on their bodies.

PART TIME WORK

What is the purpose of recruiting a part-time student?

The aim is to contribute to the growth of your students as productive individuals who are disciplined by providing them with both financial gain and practical skills by working in temporary jobs in their spare time outside their class hours.

When are student recruitments made?

Student recruitments are made at the beginning of each academic year (October). In case of need, it is in the middle of the term (February). There is no student recruitment except for these periods.

FOOD GRANT


