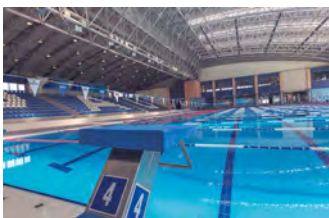

### HASAN KASAPOĞLU CULTURE CENTER

The Hasan Kasapoğlu Culture Center, located on the Kınıklı Campus, is a modern performance venue with a seating capacity of 550. Hosting theatre, concert, opera, musical, and dance performances, the center is among Türkiye's important stages with its advanced stage technology and acoustic features. It is also used as a stage by the Denizli State Theatre.

### PROF. DR. HÜSEYİN YILMAZ CONGRESS AND CULTURE CENTER

It hosts conferences, symposiums, panels, and various cultural events in 11 small halls with a total capacity of 1,120 people and a large hall with a capacity of 616 people.

### FOOD SERVICES

The central dining hall located on the Kınıklı Campus provides meal services for students in different halls. In addition, various cafes and restaurants are located on the campus. Special dietary services are also provided for students with gluten intolerance and celiac disease.

Denizli also stands out with its deep-rooted cultural heritage. Traditional textile products, especially those woven in the Buldan district, are known worldwide for their patterned, colorful designs. The Kaleiçi Bazaar and Babadağlılar Bazaar in the city center are important centers of city life, offering a wide range of shopping options, from textiles to local handicrafts.
